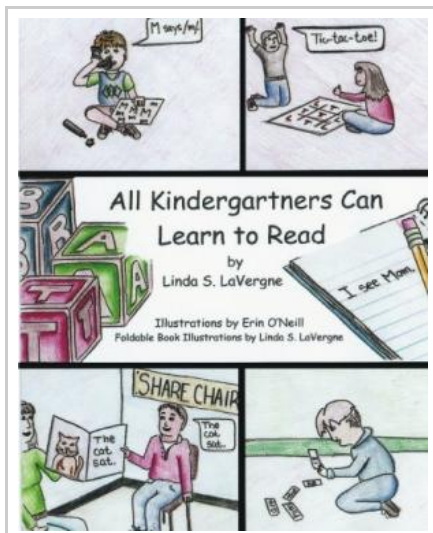




All Kindergartners Can Learn to Read (Paperback)
