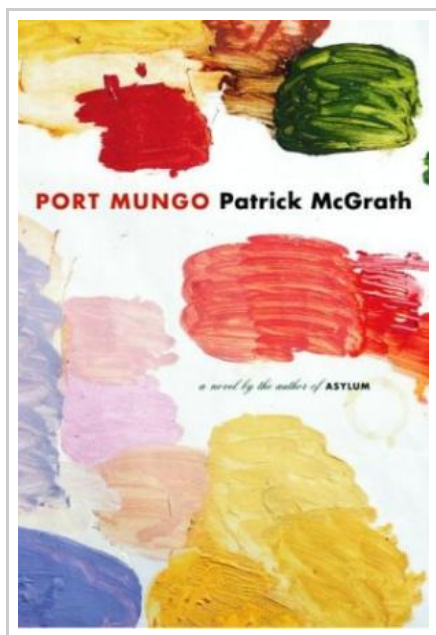




Port Mungo
